1.(1) This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Krishi Evam Prodyogik Vishvavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 2014.

(2) This Act shall supersede the Uttar Pradesh Krishi Evam Prodyogik Vishvavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1958 as amended from time to time.

(3) It shall extend to the whole State of Uttar Pradesh.

(4) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government, may, by notification in the Government Gazette, announce.
